As writer, my chief responsibility was the composition of a 12-page quarterly newspaper (the “ICPI Report”). The Report was distributed nationwide to over 25,000 people in the insurance industry and in law enforcement. Another responsibility was the writing of speeches for the ICPI directors and regional managers and, from time to time, members of the Board of Governors.
